

CONFEDERATE STATES OF AMERICA VOTER REGISTRATION ELIGIBILITY & INSTRUCTIONS

Use your voter registration form to:

1. Register to vote in the elections of the Confederate States of America.
2. Change the name on a current voter registration.
3. Change the address on a current voter registration.

To be eligible to register to vote you must:

1. Be a citizen of one of the sovereign states of the Confederate States of America.
2. Be at least 18 years of age
4. Not be adjudged incapacitated by a court of law.
5. Not be confined under a sentence of imprisonment.
6. Not be on probation or parole after a conviction of a Felony, until finally discharged.
7. Not have been convicted of a felony or Misdemeanor connected with the right of suffrage.

Other information:

1. You must be 18 years of age by the day of a particular election to be eligible to vote in that election.
2. If mailed, this form must be postmarked by the 4th Wednesday one month prior to election.

If registering by mail for the first time, you must provide a copy of appropriate identification, current or valid photo ID, or other documentation that shows your name, age, and current address.

3. Submitting this application to an individual other than the election authority does not ensure timely voter registration.
